<b>PART NUMBER</b>	675-3	677-1 (Black), 677-2 (White)
<b>HOOD TYPE</b>	Protects kitchens with traditional range hoods above the cooking surface	Protects kitchens with traditional microwaves or cabinets above the cooking surface
<b>CLEARANCE</b>	24-35 inches	15-27 inches
<b>MOUNTING*</b>	Attaches by a pre-installed magnet to underside of ventilation hood	Included wall fasteners for dry-wall or stud installation. Optional adhesive pads or material-specific hardware, not included
<b>POSITIONING</b>	Position each canister at the midpoint between the center of the front and back burner on each side of cooktop surface	Position one unit directly above front and back burner on each side of cooktop. The center of the rear canister must be over the rear burner.
